TANKER OVER WINTER.



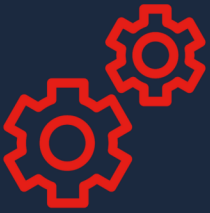
Regular Inspections

Inspect fittings, valves, and hoses for leaks or wear. Inspect seals and gaskets for wear and tear. Replace them as needed.



Tyre Pressure

Make sure to monitor your tanker's tyre pressure regularly. Rotate tyres to ensure even wear which will in return extend their lifespan.



System Checks

Checking the brake system of your tanker, including pads, discs, and brake lines. Inspect the suspension system for signs of damage or wear.



Draining Down Pumps

Ensuring this is completed is critical and will prevent these pumps from freezing overnight if the temperature drops below zero.



Fluid Checks

Monitor fluid levels, including oil, coolant, anti-freeze and hydraulic fluids.



Emergency Response Planning

Make sure you have an emergency response plan in place for your team. Ensure that all emergency equipment, are present and in working condition.
